1. In accordance with the Interagency Agreement (IAG) and the Community Relations Plan the first meeting of the Technical Review Committee (TRC) was held in the Army Conference Room at 6:00 P.M. on October 20, 1992.
2. Attendance sheet is enclosed.
3. The enclosed agenda was discussed. LTC Duane Brandt welcomed everybody especially the three members of the community. Mr Derek Romitti of the U.S. Toxic and Hazardous Materials Agency (USATHAMA) gave an overview of the National Priorities List process and the work that has been done at the IAAP to date, as well as a description of work to come. Ms. Paulette Shepherd of Camp, Dresser and McKee, Federal Programs Corp. (one of the subcontractors performing work at IAAP) presented some of the work that has been done with soil gas technology at the IAAP. Ms. Shepherd outlined work that had been accomplished at Lines 1 and 2 as well as the fire training pit.
4. During the Question and Answer period Mr. Bob Arbige stated that some of the work being conducted appeared to be an "overkill". It was denoted by the USATHAMA, IAAP, and EPA project managers that the information being gathered and assimilated will be utilized in the Risk Assessment(RA). The RA will be used to ascertain the degree of further work that will be undertaken. It was also noted that some decisions are being made to undertake some "removals" such as that with the movement of the old coal pile to the new coal pile. Mr. Arbige also noted that a great deal of knowledge about previous activities could be found by interviewing "old timers". It was noted that an extensive records search has been conducted which included interviewing former employees.
5. Mr. Romitti stated that the next TRC meeting will probably occur in six months and that all committee members would be contacted.
6. The meeting was adjourned around 7:45 P.M.





1. On May 19, 1993 a Technical Review Committee (TRC) meeting was held at 6:00 P.M. in Building 100-101, Army Conference Room. The purpose of the TRC was to discuss the Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study work being conducted at the IAAP in conjunction with analyzing the contamination at the IAAP. Attendance sheet and Agenda are enclosed.


2. Mr. Derek Romitti, U.S. Army Environmental Center presented an overview of the program.

3. Mr. Brendan McGinnis presented some geological data pertaining to the inert landfill.

4. Mr. Romitti followed with a discussion of the off post contamination and the efforts to analyze it. Mr. Romitti stated that we had received two confirmed instances of RDX contamination in several residences' drinking water. Permission to provide bottled water was obtained by AEC from the Under Secretary of the of the Army, Mr. D. Walker, DA Headquarters Washington D.C. permission was received immediately. Bottled water is being provided to these residences until a more permanent solution can be provided.

Mr. Romitti discussed the expanded sampling effort. This involved obtaining samples from 54 additional residences in suspected areas. Of the 54 drinking water samples there were three residences where additional RDX contamination was encountered.

These RDX values were just above the 2 ppb action level. Mr. Romitti stated confirmatory samples from these residences were obtained on May 18, 1993. It was noted that three of the five potential residences are currently signed up to obtain Rathburn Water, a local rural water service. Rathburn plans on installing a water line to service these areas by October 1993.
