The U.S. Army will hold a public meeting on the Proposed Plan for Operable Unit 5 and the Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis for the Historical Small Arms Range, Iowa Army Ammunition Plant

The U.S. Army (Army) in conjunction with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (US EPA) has conducted a remedial investigation, feasibility study and human health risk assessment at Operable Unit 5 and an Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) for the Historical Small Arms Range at the Iowa Army Ammunition Plant (IAAAP). A document titled Proposed Plan for Military Munitions Response Program, Operable Unit 5 and a document titled Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis (EE/CA) for the Historical Small Arms Range are available for public review online at www.iaaap.adminrecord.com and by hard copy at the IAAAP Information Repository, 17571 DMC Highway 79 Middletown, Iowa 52638-5000.

Operable Unit 5, IAAAP, consists of eight munitions response sites. This Proposed Plan summarizes information that is presented in detail in the Remedial Investigation (RI) and the Feasibility Study (FS) and proposes a preferred remedy. The Army is proposing the preferred alternatives of No Further Action for four sites, institutional controls for three sites and removal of RDX with offsite disposal plus institutional controls for one site.

The Historical Small Arms Range EE/CA determines whether there is a need to perform a removal action, and if so, evaluate alternatives and select the preferred action. This EE/CA proposes Soil Removal, Treatment, and Off-Site Disposal to treat lead in the soil.

Public Comment Period – May 6, 2013 to June 4, 2013.

The Army will hold a 30-day public comment period for the Proposed Plan and the EE/CA from May 6, 2013 to June 4, 2013. The Army will consider all formal relevant

comments prior to making a final decision.
