

**IOWA ARMY AMMUNITION PLANT
RESTORATION ADVISORY BOARD
November 21, 2002**

The Restoration Advisory Board meeting was called to order by Richard Johnson at 5:05 p.m. on November 21, 2002 at the Burlington Ballroom located in the Burlington Apartments.

Minutes Review

The minutes were accepted as written.

Agenda Review

There were no changes made to the agenda.

Public Comment

There were no comments made at this time.

Flyover

Rodger Allison briefed the RAB from briefing charts. See exhibit 3 for his presentation.

Eric Orth asked which isotopes were found. Rodger explained that they haven't narrowed down the isotopes yet, but they think it is depleted uranium. Vaughn Moore asked what was used to be sure that the pilots didn't miss a spot in the survey. A navigation system was used to ensure that the pilots were flying on the correct lines. There was also a technician flying with the pilots to monitor the equipment. He also asked if Spring Creek was flown. Rodger explained that there wasn't anything that led the Army to believe Spring Creek was affected. Nancy Cawavit-Harman asked if the former residential area in Middletown was flown. Rodger explained that it was.

Air Monitoring

Jean Brewster briefed the RAB from briefing charts. See exhibit 4 for her presentation.

Mark Hagerla asked if AET was covered under their air permit. Jean explained that they had their own air permit. The commander explained that because AET is a tenant at an Army installation she would be copied on all of their permit requests and violations. Alison Hart asked if air monitoring was a condition of their lease. Jean explained that is a condition of the operation they are conducting. Vaughn asked if there were air monitoring stations on the plant now. Jean explained that monitoring devices were on the boilers and the Contaminated Waste Processor. Joel Behne asked if Jean felt the people in the surrounding areas were being protected. She explained that she was comfortable that people were being protected.

Dan McGhee commended the work that was done on the flyover. He explained that the team worked through difficult issues and contentious points. There was a good effort made by everyone involved.

Marketing Strategy

Richard Johnson asked if it was possible to put the last two years of documents on the website. Rodger explained that two of the repositories do not have access to a computer. The newer documents will be in electronic format and will be placed on the environmental website that is under development.
