

**Iowa Army Ammunition Plant  
Restoration Advisory Board  
Minutes  
March 28, 2006**

The Restoration Advisory Board meeting was called to order by Eric Orth 5:00 p.m. on March 28, 2006 at the Winegard Board Room located in the Burlington/West Burlington Area Chamber of Commerce.

**Minutes Review**

The minutes were accepted as written.

**Agenda Review**

**Facilities Reduction Presentation**

Rodger Allison briefed the RAB from a slide presentation. Please see Exhibit 3 for his presentation.

Paula Graham asked if Line 6 would be the most expensive line to demolish. Rodger stated that they believe that it will be the most expensive.

Lasca Yerington asked if it was safe for the cattle to graze on the old Line 7 site. Rodger stated that sampling has been performed and those samples are coming back clean. He also stated that reseeded would also be done at Line 7.

Eric Orth asked if there was a cost difference between the initial plans to burn some of the buildings at Line 7 versus the conventional method of demolition that was used at Line 7. Rodger stated that he was unsure at this time.

Scott Marquess stated that the issue of burning is becoming an increasingly difficult issue and one that will be monitored closely in the future.

**Project Update**

Rick Arnseth briefed the RAB from a slide presentation. Please see exhibit 4 for his presentation.

Paula Graham asked where the plume is coming from at Line 800. She wondered if it was coming from the Line 800 lagoon. Rick stated that it isn't coming from the Lagoon

anymore because that contamination has been removed, he stated what we are seeing now in the groundwater are remnants of that contamination.

Eric Orth asked if the contaminants are being pushed around during the injections of corn syrup. Rick stated that he didn't believe that the contamination is being pushed around.

Paula Graham asked how much area is Freon contaminated. Rick stated that we are unsure at this time, but that it is a relatively small area.

Scott Marquess also responded by saying that the levels of Freon in the contaminated areas are low and is at almost drinkable levels.

Jeff Bergman asked if carbon injection into the areas with Freon is also a treatment method. Rick stated that it is a treatment method.

Paula Graham asked what was done with the tubs and tubs full of Freon that was left over from production. The general response from the crowd was that no one really knows the answer.
