

**IOWA ARMY AMMUNITION PLANT
RESTORATION ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES
January 13, 2015**

The Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meeting was called to order by Jesse Kahler at 9:00 a.m. on January 13, 2015 at the Burlington Public Library.

Minutes Review

The October 2014 meeting minutes were accepted as written.

Agenda Review

Agenda accepted as written.

Public Comment

Vaughn Moore inquired about the OU9 Public Meeting notice that was printed in the Burlington Hawkeye newspaper.

Dean Vickstrom requested that the RAB know about newspaper notices before they are printed. Steve Bellrichard briefed the RAB about OU9 sites. Melenie Wonderlich suggested that the Army send RAB members future public notices.

FUSRAP Update

Jesse Kahler stated that FUSRAP could not attend today's RAB meeting. Brenton Barkley with FUSRAP did provide a fact sheet handout shown in exhibit 3 (FUSRAP Fact Sheet). Jesse also briefed the RAB with FUSRAP updates.

Vaughn Moore asked if the paperwork for funding for the demo of Building 1-70 has been processed. Jesse Kahler replied that the paper has been processed.

Vaughn Moore asked if land is still being cleared out at FS12. Jesse Kahler said that an archeologist will be investigating soon before they can clear brush etc. this spring. Vaughn asked if any equipment has been used yet. Jesse Kahler replied that FUSRAP has processed contaminated soil through equipment at FS12. There is a plan for future cleanup outside of FS12.

Paula Graham asked if depleted uranium has been found. Jesse Kahler replied that DU has been found at FS12. Paula Graham then asked how much soil needs to be cleaned up. Jesse Kahler explained that the contamination is spread over a large area and will take some time for cleanup.

Steve Bellrichard briefed the RAB about the Building Demo Project. There are 13 buildings in the review process for demolition. None of the buildings are explosive and none have PBC contamination, subject to supplemental environmental assessment. Building 1-70, which has explosive contamination, will not be put into the system until the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) has approved the building demo by March 2015.

Vaughn Moore asked if the only building in Line 1 is the 70 powder building. Steve Bellrichard thought there are other buildings. Vaughn Moore asked if there are 200 buildings to be demoed. Steve Bellrichard said yes, there is a list of all the buildings for demo.

Vaughn Moore said during WWII they made shells for the British with mercury fulminate and nothing has been mentioned about locating mercury fulminate in the cleanup process. Leon Baxter said there was a cleanup process years ago at the burning grounds and Line 6 through the RCRA program.

IAAAP PBC Project Update

Rick Arnseth of Tetra Tech was absent. Jesse Kahler briefed the RAB from Tetra Tech's slide presentation shown in exhibit 4 (IAAAP PBC Project Update).

New Topics/Old Business

George Dieckmann asked for examples of contracts the Army is working on. Jesse Kahler explained that they are double checking on some information; there are some issues that are being addressed so we can make the best decisions to move forward.

Vaughn Moore asked for an update on Trench 5 at the IDA. Steve Bellrichard stated that as part of RCRA requirements, we continue to sample. Our path forward is to complete the groundwater investigation. The ultimate goal is to merge RCRA and CERLA; Trench 6 and 7 are CERCLA monitoring and Trench 1-5 are RCRA monitoring.

Dean Vickstrom asked for an update on Mathes Lake. Jen Busard stated that the Army has received the Draft Preliminary Assessment Work Plan, which is to be final in February.
