

**IOWA ARMY AMMUNITION PLANT
RESTORATION ADVISORY BOARD MINUTES
April 21, 2015**

The Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meeting was called to order by Elyn Holton-Dean at 9:00 a.m. on April 21, 2015 at the Burlington Public Library.

Minutes Review

The January 2015 meeting minutes were accepted as written.

Agenda Review

Public Comment

There were no public comments.

FUSRAP Update

Brenton Barkley, FUSRAP program manager briefed the RAB from his slide presentation shown in exhibit 3 (IAAAP FUSRAP Update).

Bruce Workman asked what the threshold is. Brenton Barkley replied that the soil is read on a conveyer belt to detect and sort. It is 85% effective. The clean soil is also re-sampled and used as backfill. Bruce Workman asked when you do the gross dig, how is the scan sample taken? Brenton Barkley replied it is a survey, a gamma walk over. DU gives off a high signature which is easy to detect. All contaminated soil is shipped out by sealed rail car.

Zaynab Murray asked if the soil is trucked from the firing sites to the rail cars. Brenton Barkley replied that it is transported by covered trucks. All areas are again scanned for contamination.

Vaughn Moore asked where are the contaminated stock piles kept? Brenton Barkley replied that is it at FS12 covered and is dust controlled and kept wet. Berms are built around the piles. It is also air monitored.

Vaughn Moore asked what will be done with the cut down brush. Brenton Barkley replied it will be mulched and ran through the sorter. Trees will also be scanned per EPA concerns about contaminated trees.

IAAAP PBC Project Update

Rick Arnseth, Tetra Tech project manager briefed the RAB from his slide presentation shown in exhibit 4 (IAAAP PBC Project Update).

Steve Bellrichard gave a brief update on the building demolition project.

IAAAP Mathes Lake Update

Patrick Schauble, H&S Environmental senior project manager briefed the RAB from his slide presentation shown in exhibit 5 (IAAAP Mathes Lake Update).

IAAAP Contracting Update

Zaynab Murray, Army restoration project manager briefed the RAB with a hand-out shown in exhibit 6 (IAAAP Contracting Update).

Zaynab Murray introduced Matt Dayoc, AEC Environmental Restoration Manager.

Vaughn Moore asked for an update on Trench 5, RCRA IDA Trench. Steve Bellrichard explained the issue with Trench 5 needs further investigation to determine why there are contaminants in the groundwater.
