

**IOWA ARMY AMMUNITION PLANT  
RESTORATION ADVISORY BOARD  
MINUTES  
October 16, 2007**

The Restoration Advisory Board meeting was called to order by Eric Orth at 5:05 p.m. on October 16, 2007 at the Winegard Board Room located in the Burlington/West Burlington Area Chamber of Commerce.

**Minutes Review**

The minutes were accepted as written.

**Agenda Review**

Rodger Allison mentioned the passing of Glen Fullhart, who was a RAB member since it's inception in 1997. The RAB took a moment of silence to remember him and his family.

**FUSRAP Update**

**Remedial Investigation**

Sivert Iversen questioned what buildings explosives contamination was found in. Ron Frerker explained that explosives contamination was found in the soil; the buildings were only checked for radiological contamination.

**Facilities Reduction Program**

Dan Nelson questioned how the Army addresses the Indiana bat problem during the building demolition process. Rodger Allison explained that the Army completed a Baseline Ecological Risk Assessment (BERA). Rodger further explained that the buildings are assessed individually and the Army still has to address Indiana bat issues on a site-by-site basis using the BERA criteria. The Natural Resources Manager at the installation makes an assessment before the buildings are taken down to determine if there are any bat issues.

**Public Comment**

Rodger Allison explained that during the July 2007 RAB meeting, Vaughn Moore questioned the existence of the old hospital incinerator. Rodger explained that he has done some research and a hospital incinerator did once exist. Rodger further explained that IRP would likely address the site and take samples to characterize it.

Rodger mentioned that during the July 2007 RAB meeting, Vaughn Moore also questioned the existence of a fence adjacent to the roadway by gate 1. Rodger explained that he drove out to gate 1 and could not find the fence that Vaughn questioned. He might have been talking about the barricades placed along the fence as a security measure.


Scott Marquess mentioned the RAB frequency and suggested less frequent meetings. The RAB will discuss further during the next meeting since a full quorum is not present.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:20 p.m.


